#### **Registration Discounts**

#### **Player Withdrawals**

Withdrawals on or prior to 07/14/17 will receive a refund equal to registration fees paid, less \$200. There is no refund available for any player who withdraws after 07/14/17. Players who withdraw keep their Player Packs.
